Maple Lane Concrete Project TO BEGIN IN SEPTEMBER!

On September 9, 2015, the Maple Lane Concrete Project will begin. New concrete will be poured from the front entrances of Apartments 1-14, and a new concrete sidewalk will be laid from these apartments to the main side-

walk. The main sidewalk and the ramp ways leading to the parking lot will also be reconfigured, and upon completion they will be ADA compliant. The work on this project will be dependent upon the weather and parking will be limited in the lot during the construction. Once completed, these apartments will have a larger patio out their front door and there will no longer be a need for ramps leading up to each apartment's front entrance. The new concrete will be poured so that it slopes up to the front entrance of each apartment making it easier and safer to enter and exit the apartments. This project is scheduled to be completed by mid-October. This is project is another enhancement from the Carroll County Housing Authority designed specifically for the wellbeing of our residents!



PEANUT BUTTER APPLE • • **DESSERT RECIPE**

INGREDIENTS

- * I-I/2 cups graham cracker crumbs
- * 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- * 1/2 cup plus 1/3 cup peanut butter, divided
- * I/4 cup butter, melted
- * I package (8 oz.) cream cheese, softened
- * 3/4 cup sugar
- * I carton (16 oz.) frozen whipped topping,
- * 2 cans (21 oz. each) apple pie filling
- * 3/4 cup confectioners' sugar
- * I teaspoon ground cinnamon

DIRECTIONS

- * In a large bowl, combine the graham cracker 🛡 🛡 crumbs, brown sugar, 1/2 cup peanut butter • • and butter; spoon half into a 3-qt. bowl.
- * In a large bowl, beat the cream cheese and sugar until smooth; fold in whipped topping. 👝 🛭 Spread half over crumb mixture in the bowl. Top with one can of apple pie filling.
- * Combine the confectioners' sugar, cinna-
- mon, and remaining peanut butter until crum-
- bly; sprinkle half over pie filling. Repeat the

layers. Refrigerate until serving.

Yield: about 20 servings.


