CHEESEBURGER CUPS RECIPE

A terrific recipe for moms with young kids and busy lives, this is a very simple, inexpensive dish that is made with handy ingredients and takes just a short time. Best of all, kids will go crazy for these darling dinner bites!

INGREDIENTS

- * 1 pound ground beef
- * 1/2 cup ketchup
- * 2 tablespoons brown sugar
- * 1 tablespoon prepared mustard
- * 1-1/2 teaspoons Worcestershire sauce
- * 1 tube (12 oz.) refrigerated buttermilk biscuits
- * 1/2 cup cubed cheese (Velveeta)

DIRECTIONS

- * In a large skillet, cook beef over medium heat until no longer pink; drain. Stir in the ketchup, brown sugar, mustard, and Worcestershire sauce. Remove from the heat; set aside.
- * Press each biscuit on the bottom and up the sides of a greased muffin cup. Spoon beef mixture into cups; top with cheese cubes. Bake at 400° for 14-16 minutes or until golden brown. **Yield:** 5 servings.

NATIONAL CANDY MONTH



While we may celebrate candy all year long, June has the privilege of being the official Candy Month. Following are some Candy Fun Facts:

- Halloween has the highest candy grossing sales, Easter is second.
- M&M's is the number one selling candy in the United States with annual sales of \$673.2 million. Reese's Peanut Butter Cup is number two with sales of \$516.5 million.
- Sixty million chocolate Easter bunnies are produced each year.
- Chewing gum is over 3,000 years old.
- Gummy Bears originated in Germany.
- Depending on its size, a jawbreaker can take from two-weeks to a month to manufacture not including polishing.
- The Snickers candy bar, which was introduced in 1929 by Frank and Ethel Mars, was named after the family horse.
- A one-ounce piece of milk chocolate and a cup of decaffeinated coffee contain the same amount of caffeine.
- 2.8 billion pounds of chocolate are consumed in America each year, which is over 11 pounds per person.
- Daniel Peter and Henri Nestle created milk chocolate in 1875.
- The melting point of cocoa butter is just below the body temperature, which is why chocolate melts when you put it in your mouth.
- Machine-spun cotton candy was invented in 1897 by the dentist William Morrison and confectioner John C. Wharton and first introduced to a wide audience at the 1904 World's Fair in St. Louis. It is mostly air.
- Candy canes were invented in 1670 in Germany as a way of keeping children quiet in church.
- Some candies, such as lollipops, candy canes, gummy bears, gum drops, licorice twist and sour balls are free of fat and cholesterol, making them a healthier treat than many people realize.
