



ILLINOIS LOW INCOME HOME ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Illinois Low Income Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is designed to assist eligible low income households pay for winter energy services. LIHEAP will provide a one-time benefit to eligible households to be used for energy bills.

In addition, a Tri-County Opportunities Council representative will be available at Mest Manor (525 Third St., Savanna, IL) on **WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 14TH,** to meet with eligible Carroll County Housing Authority residents, and assist them with completing the LIHEAP application. . **APPLE CRISP PIZZA** RECIPE

INGREDIENTS

- * Pastry for a single-crust pie
- * 2/3 cup sugar
- * 3 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- * I teaspoon ground cinnamon
- * 4 medium baking apples, peeled and cut
- into 1/2-inch slices
- TOPPING:
- * 1/2 cup all-purpose flour
- * 1/3 cup packed brown sugar
- * I/3 cup rolled oats
- * I teaspoon ground cinnamon
- * 1/4 cup butter, softened
- * I/4 to I/2 cup caramel ice cream topping
- * Vanilla ice cream, optional

DIRECTIONS

- * Roll pastry to fit a 12-in. pizza pan; fold under • 2.
- or flute the edges. Combine sugar, flour and $\bullet \bullet_3$
- cinnamon in a bowl. Add apples and toss. $\bullet \bullet 4$
- Arrange the apples in a single layer in a circular $\bullet \bullet 5$ • pattern to completely cover pastry. Combine $\bullet \bullet \bullet \bullet$
- the first five topping ingredients; sprinkle over
- the apples.
- * Bake at 350° for 35-40 minutes or until
- apples are tender. Remove from the oven
- and immediately drizzle with caramel topping.
- Serve warm with ice cream if desired.


