Mom's Lemon Custard PIE RECIPE

INGREDIENTS

- * I cup sugar
- * I tablespoon butter, softened
- * 2 eggs, separated
- * I cup milk
- * 3 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- * I/8 teaspoon salt
- * I/4 cup lemon juice
- * 2 teaspoons grated lemon peel
- * I unbaked pie pastry (9 inches)
- * Whipped cream, lemon & mint optional DIRECTIONS
- * Preheat oven to 325°. In a large bowl, beat sugar and butter until well blended. Add egg yolks, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Add milk, flour, and salt; mix well. Stir in lemon juice and peel; set aside. In a small bowl, beat egg whites until stiff peaks form; gently fold into lemon mixture.
 - * Pour into pie shell. Bake I hour or until lightly browned. Cool. Garnish with whipped cream, lemon and mint if desired. Store in the refrigerator.
 - Yield: 6-8 servings.
