### DUTCH APPLE CAKE RECIPE

A traditional Dutch recipe that is a favorite, as well as, perfect for a potluck, or other get-together.

#### INGREDIENTS

- \* 3 medium tart apples, peeled and cut into 1/4-inch slices (3 cups)
- \* 3 tablespoons plus 1 cup sugar, divided
- \* 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- \* 2/3 cup butter, softened
- \* 4 large eggs
- \* 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- \* 2 cups all-purpose flour
- \* 1/8 teaspoon salt

#### DIRECTIONS

- \* In a large bowl, combine the apples, 3 tablespoons sugar and cinnamon; let stand for one hour.
- \* In another bowl, cream butter and remaining sugar until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Add vanilla. Combine flour and salt; gradually add to creamed mixture and beat until smooth.
- \* Transfer to a greased 9x5-inch loaf pan. Push apple slices vertically into batter, placing them close together.
- \* Bake at 300° for 1-1/2 to 1-3/4 hours or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean. Cool for 10 minutes before removing from pan to wire rack. Serve warm.

**YIELD:** 12 servings.
