DUTCH APPLE CAKE RECIPE

A traditional Dutch recipe that is a favorite, as well as,

perfect for a potluck, or other get-together.

- **INGREDIENTS**
- * 3 medium tart apples, peeled and cut into
- 1/4-inch slices (3 cups)
- * 3 tablespoons plus I cup sugar, divided
- * I teaspoon ground cinnamon
- * 2/3 cup butter, softened
- * 4 large eggs
- * I teaspoon vanilla extract
- * 2 cups all-purpose flour
- * 1/8 teaspoon salt

DIRECTIONS

* In a large bowl, combine the apples, 3 table-• spoons sugar and cinnamon; let stand for one hour.

- * In another bowl, cream butter and remaining sugar until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a 👝 time, beating well after each addition. Add
- vanilla. Combine flour and salt; gradually add to
- creamed mixture and beat until smooth.
- * Transfer to a greased 9x5-inch loaf pan. Push • apple slices vertically into batter, placing them
- close together.
- * Bake at 300° for 1-1/2 to 1-3/4 hours or until
- ullet a toothpick inserted in the center comes out ulletclean. Cool for 10 minutes before removing
- from pan to wire rack. Serve warm.
