WHITE CHOCOLATE **PUMPKIN DREAMS RECIPE**

If you like pumpkin pie, you'll love

- these delicious pumpkin cookies dotted
- with white chocolate chips and chopped
- pecans. Drizzled with a brown sugar icing,
- they're irresistible!

INGREDIENTS:

- * I cup butter, softened
- * 1/2 cup sugar
- * I/2 cup packed brown sugar
- * | egg
- * 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- I cup canned pumpkin
- * 2 cups all-purpose flour
- * 3-1/2 teaspoons pumpkin pie spice
- * I teaspoon baking powder
- * I teaspoon baking soda
- * I/4 teaspoon salt
- * I package (10-12 oz.) white baking chips
- * I cup chopped pecans
- PENUCHE FROSTING:
- * 1/2 cup packed brown sugar
- * 3 tablespoons butter
- * I/4 cup milk
- * I-I/2 to 2 cups confectioners' sugar
- DIRECTIONS
- In a large bowl, cream butter and sugars
- until light and fluffy. Beat in the egg, vanilla

WHITE CHOCOLATE PUMPKIN **DREAMS RECIPE CONT'D**

- * Combine dry ingredients; gradually add
- to the creamed mixture and mix well. Stir
- in chips and pecans.
- * Drop by rounded teaspoonful 2 in. apart
- onto ungreased baking sheet. Bake at 350°
 - for 12-14 minutes or until firm. Remove to
 - wire racks to cool.
- * For frosting, combine brown sugar and
- butter in a small saucepan. Bring to a boil;
- cook over medium heat for 1 minute or
- until slightly thickened. Cool for 10 minutes.
- Add milk; beat until smooth. Beat in
- enough confectioners' sugar to reach the
- desired consistency. Spread over cooled
- cookies. YIELD: 4-1/2 dozen.
