# **FESTIVE MINT CREAM DESSERT RECIPE**

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Mint ice cream and colorful sprinkles make

- this concoction perfect for a St. Patrick's
- Day celebration. For a chocolaty dessert,
- use rocky road or chocolate ice cream
- instead. YIELD: 24 servings.

### **INGREDIENTS**

- \* 3/4 cup butter, divided
- \* I package (16 ounces) chocolate cream-
- filled sandwich cookies, crushed
- \* 8 cups mint chocolate chip ice cream, softened
- \* I-I/2 cups milk chocolate chips
- I cup confectioners' sugar
- \* 3/4 cup evaporated milk
- \* I carton (16 ounces) frozen whipped
- topping, thawed
- \* Chocolate syrup and red and green
- sprinkles, optional
- DIRECTIONS
- \* In a microwave, melt 1/2 cup butter. Stir in cookie crumbs. Press into a 13-in.x9-in. dish. Freeze for 30 minutes or until firm. Spread ice cream over crust; return to the freezer until firm.
- \* In a large saucepan, combine chocolate
- chips, confectioners' sugar, milk and the
- remaining butter. Bring to a boil, stirring

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- Cool to room temperature. When cool,
- spread over ice cream; return to freezer until firm.
- Spread whipped topping over ice cream
- (dish will be full.) Cover and freeze until firm or overnight.
- \* Remove from the freezer 15-20 minutes before serving. If desired, drizzle with
- chocolate syrup and top with sprinkles.

# 2021 IL NAHRO POSTER CONTEST

Illinois NAHRO (National Association of Housing & Redevelopment Officials) is partnering with North Central Regional Council of

NAHRO (NCRC) and National NAHRO to promote the "WHAT HOME MEANS TO ME" Contest. The poster contest provides an opportunity for children residing in affordable housing and community developments to reflect the national theme of "What Home Means to Me." This is an important way for the children of our communities to have their voices heard with policy makers at all levels.

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Youth who submit posters must be in grades K-12. The age selection categories are as follows: Elementary: K to 5th grade; Middle: 6th to 8th grade; and High: 9th to 12 grade.

Winners of the state contest entries will be submitted by IL NAHRO to NCRC for the regional competition. NCRC will then select three winners-one from each age category-and will forward those winners to the national competition in Washington, D.C.

National prizes will include 12 winners to receive a \$100 gift card. The grand prize cover winner will also receive an iPad and a framed copy of their original artwork. The cover winner and one legal guardian will also receive a tour of Capitol Hill and attend NAHRO's 2022 Washington Conference in Washington, D.C. where he or she will be honored.
