## WINNING APPLE **CRISP RECIPE**

- **INGREDIENTS**
- \* I cup all-purpose flour
- \* 3/4 cup rolled oats
- \* I cup packed brown sugar
- \* I teaspoon ground cinnamon
- \* 1/2 cup butter, softened
- \* 4 cups chopped peeled apples
- \* I cup sugar
- \* 2 tablespoons cornstarch
- \* I cup water
- \* I teaspoon vanilla extract

#### DIRECTIONS

- \* Pre-heat oven to 350°. In a large bowl,
- combine the first 4 ingredients. Cut in butter 🕈 until crumbly. Press half into a greased 9-in. square baking pan. Cover with apples.
- In a small saucepan, combine the sugar, corn-
- starch, water and vanilla. Bring to a boil; cook
- and stir 2 minutes or until thick and clear. Pour over apples. Sprinkle with the remaining crumb
- 🖕 mixture.
- \* Bake 60-65 minutes or until apples are tender. Serve warm, with vanilla ice cream if desired. YIELD: 8 servings.
