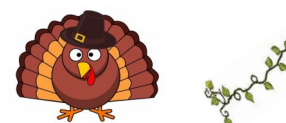

PUMPKIN PIE CUPCAKES WITH WHIPPED CREAM

Combine two loves, cupcakes and pie, into one amazing treat. These pumpkin cupcakes have a pie crust bottom and a snow white topping.

- INGREDIENTS:**
- * 1 sheet refrigerated pie crust
- * 1 can (15 ounces) solid-pack pumpkin
- * 4 large eggs, room temperature
- * 1/2 cup canola oil
- * 1/2 cup water
- * 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- * 3 cups all-purpose flour
- * 2 cups sugar
- * 1 tablespoon cornstarch
- * 2 teaspoons baking powder
- * 1 teaspoon baking soda
- * 1 teaspoon pumpkin pie spice
- * 1/2 teaspoon salt

- WHIPPED CREAM:**
- * 2 cups heavy whipping cream
- * 1/2 cup confectioners' sugar
- * Ground cinnamon

- DIRECTIONS**
- * Preheat oven to 350°. Line 24 muffin cups with foil liners.
- * On a work surface, unroll crust. Cut 24 circles with a floured 2-1/4-in. round cookie cutter, rerolling scraps as necessary.

PUMPKIN PIE CUPCAKES WITH WHIPPED CREAM CONT'D

- * Press one crust circle into each liner. Bake until lightly browned, 10-12 minutes. Cool on wire racks.
- * In a large bowl, beat pumpkin, eggs, oil, water and vanilla until well blended. In another bowl, whisk flour, sugar, cornstarch, baking powder, baking soda, pie spice and salt; gradually beat into pumpkin mixture. Pour 1/4 cup batter into each prepared cup.
- * Bake until a toothpick inserted in center comes out clean, 20-25 minutes, rotating pans halfway through baking. Cool in pans 10 minutes before removing to wire racks to cool completely.
- * For whipped cream, in a large bowl, beat the cream until it begins to thicken. Add confectioners' sugar; beat until soft peaks form. To serve, dollop over cupcakes; sprinkle with cinnamon. **YIELD:** 2 dozen.
