CARROLL COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY CARROLL APARTMENTS SIDEWALK/PATIO PROJECT UPDATE

Our designs for the new sidewalk and patio improvements at Carroll Apartments have been completed, and we are in the process of notifying contractors to bid on the project. Our goal is to have the bids returned to us by May 16th, and we will present

the bids to our Board of Commissioners for approval on May 18th. We anticipate this project to begin on June 6th. Tenants who will be affected by the construction will be notified by May 23rd to give them ample time to remove any personal items or plants outside of their unit.

The project should be completed by July 15th. This is Phase III of our Carroll Apartments Sidewalk/Patio project. Phase IV, which is our final phase at Carroll Apartments will be completed next summer (2023.) Continue to watch for updates as we get closer to this summer's Carroll Apartments project!

BERRY-PATCH BROWNIE PIZZA RECIPE

The delicious combination of fruit, almonds and chocolate

is what makes this brownie so unique. The fruit lightens the chocolate a bit and makes it feel as though you are eating something sinfully healthy!

• INGREDIENTS:

- * I package fudge brownie mix (13x9-inchpan size)
- * I/3 cup chopped unblanched almonds
- * I teaspoon almond extract

TOPPING:

- * I package (8 oz.) cream cheese (softened)
- * I tablespoon sugar
- * I teaspoon vanilla extract
- * I/2 teaspoon grated lemon zest
- * 2 cups whipped topping
- * Assorted fresh berries
- * Optional: Fresh mint leaves and coarsesugar

DIRECTIONS:

- * Preheat oven to 375°. Prepare brownie
 batter according to package directions for
- fudgelike brownie, adding almonds and
- almond extract. Spread into a greased 14-in.

pizza pan.

BERRY-PATCH BROWNIE PIZZA RECIPE CONT'D

- * Bake until a toothpick inserted in center
 comes out clean, 15-18 minutes. Cool
 completely on a wire rack.
- * Beat first 4 topping ingredients until it is
 smooth; fold in whipped topping. Spread
 over the crust to within 1/2 in. of edges;
 refrigerate, loosely covered, 2 hours.
- * To serve, cut into 12 pieces; top it with berries of choice. If desired, top with mint and sprinkle with coarse sugar.

YIELD: 12 servings.
