#### **INGREDIENTS**

- \* I box white cake mix
- \* I/2 cup butter, softened
- \* I/2 teaspoon vanilla extract
- \* 8 ounces cream cheese, softened
- \* I egg
- \* powdered sugar
- \* food coloring (Neon)
- \* candy eyeballs
- **DIRECTIONS**
- \* In a bowl, beat butter, vanilla, egg and cream cheese until fluffy.
- \* Mix the cake mix into creamed mixture.

### FREEPORT HEALTH NETWORK FLU SHOT CLINIC

As the flu season begins, it's important to get your annual flu shot. These clinics are for adults only. For their own safety, children should be immunized at their regular healthcare provider's office.

The Freeport Health Network (FHN) will be offering a flu shot clinic at our host site of **MEST MANOR** as follows:

DATE: Thursday, October 6th

TIME: 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. (Medical cards and photo IDs will be requested)

**LOCATION:** Mest Manor Dining Room (525 Third Street)

**COST:** High Dose will be \$67.00 for persons over 65 if <u>not</u> covered by Medicare Part B or Medicare Replacement Plan accepted by FHN. Persons under 65 will be given the

Quadrivalent vaccine with an out-of-pocket cost of \$31.00.

Immunizations may be paid for by cash or check payable to FHN, and you can use your receipt for reimbursement from your health insurance carrier.

If you are covered by Medicare Part B or a Medicare HMO accepted by FHN, there will be no out-of-pocket charge (**MUST** present Medicare HMO card and ID.)
