EASTER DIRT CAKE RECIPE

This Easter dirt cake is an easy and delicious no bake treat perfect to serve for

dessert on Easter! Adults will love this dirtpudding cake as much as kids do!

INGREDIENTS

- * I package (15-1/2 oz.) Oreo cookies crushed
- * I/2 cup butter softened
- * I 8 oz. package cream cheese softened
- * I cup powdered sugar
- * 3 cups milk
- * 2 boxes (3.4 oz. each) instant chocolate pudding mix
- * I 12 oz. Cool Whip thawed
- * I cup Easter M&M's
- * 20 PEEP marshmallows

DIRECTIONS

- * In a large mixing bowl, cream together the butter, cream cheese, and powdered sugar.

 Set aside.
- * In a bowl, whisk together the milk with instant chocolate pudding, until smooth.
- * Pour the pudding mix into cream cheese
 mixture. Beat until combined, scraping
 down the sides of the bowl as needed. Fold
 in Cool Whip. (recipe continued) →

DIRT CAKE RECIPE (CONT'D)

- * Prepare in a 9x13 dish by pressing half the
 Oreos on bottom, topped with the pudding
 filling and then topped with the remaining
 Oreos.
 - * Refrigerate for at least 2 hours until set. When ready to serve, sprinkle top of the cake with Easter M&M's candy and Peeps! YIELD: 15 servings.


