CARROLL COUNTY HOUSING AUTHORITY CARROLL APARTMENTS SIDEWALK/PATIO PROJECT

The Carroll Apartments Sidewalk/Patio Project is entering its final phase. Phase IV will include the following areas: Front and back of Units 5 - 8, back area of Units 21 - 22, front and back of Units 23 - 24, and the back area of Units 19 - 20. We will be installing new sidewalks, patios, and improved

drainage in these areas. The bid packages for this project will be ready in May, with the work estimated to begin in the month of June. The project should be completed in July.

We will begin taking down the remaining fencing in front of Units 5 - 8, and 23 - 24 later in the month of May. For those residents who have personal items in these areas, please begin to make arrangements to clear out this area. We will provide further information, and actual construction dates next month!

STRAWBERRY CRUNCH ICE CREAM CAKE RECIPE

• This delicious ice cream cake • was inspired by a neighborhood ice cream

- truck strawberry novelty.
- INGREDIENTS:
- * 36 Golden Oreo cookies, divided
- * 4 tablespoons butter, melted
- * 3 cups vanilla ice cream, softened
- * 5 cups strawberry ice cream, softened
- * I carton (8 oz.) frozen whipped topping,
- thawed
- * I package (I oz.) freeze-dried strawberries,
- coarsely crushed
- * Fresh strawberries, optional

DIRECTIONS:

- * Line a 9x9-in. baking pan with parchment.
- Preheat oven to 350°. Finely crush 24 Oreo
- cookies. In a small bowl, mix cookie crumbs
- and butter. Press onto bottom of prepared
- pan. Bake until firm, 25-30 minutes. Cool on
 a wire rack.
- * Spread vanilla ice cream onto crust; freeze,
- covered, until firm. Spread with strawberry
- ice cream and then whipped topping; freeze,
- covered, until firm.

- * Coarsely crush remaining Oreo cookies.
- Combine cookie crumbs and freeze-dried
- strawberries; sprinkle over whipped topping.

- ICE CREAM CAKE RECIPE CONT'D
- * Freeze, covered, until firm, 8 hours or
 overnight. Remove cake from freezer.
- Lifting with parchment, remove from pan.
- Gently peel off parchment. Let stand 10
- minutes before cutting. If desired, garnish
 with fresh strawberries.
- YIELD: 9 servings.

- Ingredients: 2 pounds of compassion
