PUMPKIN CHOCOLATE CHIP COOKIES RECIPE

Chocolate and pumpkin pair up to make this family-favorite fall cookie recipe. These pumpkin cookies are fantastic for parties and picnics!

INGREDIENTS:

- * 1 cup butter, softened
- * 3/4 cup sugar
- * 3/4 cup packed brown sugar
- * 1 large egg, room temperature
- * 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- * 2 cups all-purpose flour
- * 1 cup quick-cooking oats
- * 1 teaspoon baking soda
- * 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- * 1 cup canned pumpkin
- * 1-1/2 cups semisweet chocolate chips

DIRECTIONS

- * In a bowl, cream butter and sugars until light and fluffy, 5-7 minutes. Beat in egg and vanilla. Combine the flour, oats, baking soda and cinnamon; stir into creamed mixture alternately with pumpkin. Fold in the chocolate chips.
- * Drop by tablespoonfuls onto ungreased baking sheets.
- * Bake at 350° for 10-12 minutes or until lightly browned. Remove to wire racks to cool. **YIELD:** 4 dozen.
