CHEESEBURGER PIZZA RECIPE

When you cannot decide between a cheeseburger or a pizza, this cheeseburger recipe lets you have both. A true win-win!

INGREDIENTS

- * I/2 pound ground beef
- * I prebaked 12-inch pizza crust
- * I/2 cup ketchup
- * I/4 cup prepared mustard
- * I-I/2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- * 2 cups shredded lettuce
- * I/2 cup chopped dill pickle
- * I/4 cup chopped onion
- * I/2 cup mayonnaise
- * 2 to 3 tablespoons dill pickle juice

DIRECTIONS

- * Preheat oven to 425°. In a large skillet, cook beef over medium heat until no longer pink, 3-4 minutes, breaking it into crumbles; drain.
- * Meanwhile, place crust on an ungreased baking sheet or pizza pan. Mix ketchup and mustard; spread over crust. Add ground beef; bake 5 minutes. Sprinkle with cheese; bake until cheese is bubbly and crust is lightly browned, 8-10 min. longer.

* Top with lettuce, pickle and onion. Whisk mayonnaise and enough pickle juice to reach cesired consistency; drizzle over pizza.
