- Salted, roasted peanuts take this treat to the

- INGREDIENTS
- * 6 Tbsp. popcorn kernels
- * 1/4 cup peanut oil
- * 1/2 cup sugar
- * Cooking spray
- * I cup candy corn
- * I/2 cup salted roasted peanuts
- * 4 cups mini marshmallows (about two-
- thirds of a 10-ounce bag)
- * 4 Tbsp. salted butter
- DIRECTIONS
- * Heat a large pot over medium-high heat;
- add the popcorn kernels and peanut oil.
- When the oil starts to sizzle, sprinkle the
- sugar over the kernels. Cover with a tight-
- fitting lid and shake the pot until the popping
- slows down, about 8 minutes. Remove from
- the heat and pour the popcorn onto a
- parchment-lined baking sheet, separating the
- kernels with a spatula or spoon. Let thepopcorn cool.
- * Coat a large bowl with cooking spray and
 add the popcorn, candy corn and peanuts.

CANDY CORN POPCORN BALLS RECIPE CONT'D

* Combine the marshmallows and butter in a large pot over medium-high heat. Cook, stirring, until melted and smooth, about 5 minutes. Pour the melted marshmallow mixture over the popcorn mixture and gently stir to coat. Coat your hands with cooking spray, then shape the popcorn into 3-inch balls. Let cool. YIELDS: 12 servings.

NATIONAL FIRE PREVENTION WEEK

The theme for this year's National Fire Prevention Week, October 5 –11, 2005, is focused on Lithium-Ion Battery Safety. Most of the electronics we use in our homes every day are powered by lithium-ion batteries. Following are some important safety tips to follow related to lithium-ion battery use:

- Purchase batteries that are only listed by a nationally recognized testing laboratory and labeled accordingly.
- 2. Stop charging a battery once it is full.
- 3. Use charging equipment that is only compatible with your device.
- 4. Stop using your device if the battery shows signs of damage, such as an unusual odor, excessive heat, popping sounds, swelling, or change in color.
- 5. Have all repairs performed by a qualified professional.
